

AGRICOLA

Wood Barque – Built 1839, 658 (Courier-560) tons, by Sunderland

Captain: John Bell

Cabin: Surgeon Superintendent: Mr T. H. Mayne

Steerage: 263 Government assisted immigrants; 16 children died, 2 adults died, 1 birth; 246 arrived in good health.

Sailed from the Downs (London) Thursday, November 4, 1852 and Torbay Tuesday, November 9, 1852;

109 days later, arrived in Morton Bay, Queensland, Saturday, February 26, 1853.

22-year-old farm labourer from Cambridge, James Hammond and his wife Elizabeth (nee Lovell-age23), were aboard the *Agricola*. Later that year they travelled (one presumes sailed) south to Melbourne, arriving December 5, in time for Christmas 1853 with Henry & Mary Jane (nee Lovell) Bowland and William Lovell at Samuel & Sarah (nee Lovell) Tinkler's home in Collingwood, Victoria. William Lovell's wife Martha (nee Bowland) died, probably in childbirth, just days after arriving in Melbourne, Thursday, March 10, 1853 with the Bowlands and the Tinklers aboard the *Thames*. The Bowlands also lost Emma their newborn first child just a month after arriving.

SHIPPING INTELLIGENCE

ARRIVAL.

Feb. 26. *Agriola*, barque, 658 tons, John Bell, from the Downs 4th Nov. and Torbay 9th Nov. Passengers — Mr. T. H. Mayne, Surgeon-Superintendent, and 246 Government immigrants.

The *Agriola* arrived in the bay on Saturday last, with 246 immigrants, from England. She left Torbay on the 9th November, with 263 emigrants; and there have been 16 deaths (only 2 adults) and one birth, on the passage. The passengers are reported to be in good health. They consist of 122 married persons, 3 single men, 13 single women, and 108 children. The callings of the adults are as follow: Agricultural labourers 31; bricklayers 3; blacksmiths 2; bootmaker 1; carpenters 9; corufactor 1; coatmaker 1; domestic servants 12; gardeners 5; mason 1; painter 1; policeman 1; shepherds 4; sawyers 2; schoolmaster 1; sailmaker 1; tailors 2. With the exception of ten, they are all stated to be English.
